CMFRI develops breeding tech for Indian pompano

Mariculture in the country is set for a major boost with the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) successfully developing a seed production technology for Indian pompano.

Indian pompano (Trachinotus mookalee) has high commercial value both in domestic and international markets.

According to CMFRI Director A Gopalakrishnan, this is the first report of successful mass scale seed production of Indian pompano in the world. The technology was developed at the CM-FRI's Visakhapatnam Regional Centre after two years of research.

"The achievement is a major breakthrough in Indian mariculture business which will help the farming community to use the hatchery produced seeds of Indian pompano for cage farming," he said.
