Theeranaipunya transforms life of fisherwomen youth

Kochi: The Theeranaipunya project imparting training for skill enhancement and capacity building implemented by Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) with the support of the Society for Assistance to the Fisherwomen (SAF), has helped in transforming the lives of fisherwomen youth into a better level. The project focusing on the cognitive development of fisherwomen youth in Ernakulam district to achieve better living standard provides two-month long training programme to the educated unemployed fisherwomen youth, along with stipend. The project helps to enhance their employability skills and to help them secure suitable jobs. Three batches have successfully completed the training under the programme so far, said a CMFRI release.
