As part of the efforts to strengthen the research network for the utilisation of satellite technology in the marine fisheries sector, the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) will host a 21-day winter school from December 1 to impart extensive training to young researchers on using the latest technology for sustainable management of the marine ecosystem.

Twenty-five participants from various research institutes, agricultural universities and colleges will be trained to familiarise themselves with technology-driven models to understand the ecosystem-based management of marine wealth. Hands-on training on the utilisation of satellite data and ecosystem models for the betterment of fisheries will be given to the participants.
