Training for soil-less farming held in Ernakulam Krishi Vigyan Kendra

KOCHI: The Ernakulam Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) functioning under the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) on Wednesday organised a training programme aimed at developing entrepreneurs across the state for commercial production of soil-less media. During the programme held at the CMFRI, the technology of the soil-less mix recently developed by the KVK, was transferred to the participants.

As many as 25 participants from various districts attended the training.
