Feeding the future

One of the main global challenges faced today is how to ensure food and nutrition security for the growing population. Experts took the delegates through this at the start of the 15-day international workshop organised by the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) here on Wednesday. The workshop is aimed at training researchers from 13 member countries of the African Asian Rural Development Organisation. CMFRI director Dr A Gopalakrishnan presided over the meet.

“The technologies developed by the CMFRI in a slew of areas such as open sea cage farming and fish stock assessment will be made familiar to participants,” he said. Representatives from Taiwan, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Oman, Palestine, Sudan, Tunisia, Malaysia, Malawi, Libya, Mauritius and Bangladesh are attending the two week workshop.
