The second international symposium of the Societal Applications in Fisheries and Aquaculture Using Remote Sensing Imagery (SA-FARI), organised by the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute, concluded here on Wednesday.

The theme of the threeday symposium was "tapping satellite and remote sensing technologies to improve the fisheries sector".

Sixty-three papers were presented at various sessions that dealt with themes like bio-diversity, aquatic environment and ecology, harvest fisheries, and fisheries management.
