arge numbers of Blue button, Porpita porpita, washed ashore in Aadri Beach near Veraval during monsoon. It is a gelatinous Cnidarian, resembling Jellyfish but belongs to Class Hydrozoa. The blue button lives on the surface of the sea and consists of two main parts: the float and the hydroid colony. It competes with other drifters for food and mainly feeds on small fish, eggs, and zooplankton.
