





PREFACE

For an informed management regime to ensure sustainability of the marine fisheries, it is essential not only to have reliable information on the status of marine fish resources along with fishing effort expended but also the number of fishing villages, landing centres, fisherfolk population, their occupation status, fishing crafts, fishing gears and other related parameters. With this objective, the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI), Cochin has been conducting frame surveys at periodic intervals. Marine fisheries census on an all India basis was last conducted by CMFRI during May-July, 1980. Since the last census, the marine fisheries in India have witnessed both qualitative and quantitative changes. Post 1980 was also been a period where a number of management/policy interventions were made by the Government of India and the maritime states for ensuring sustainability, conservation of resources and to protect the interests of artisanal fishermen. Surely, the policies and interventions need to be reviewed and fine tuned in view of the highly dynamic nature of marine fisheries. For this a strong realtime and reliable database on various aspects of marine fisheries is essential. Recognising such a need, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries (DAHD&F), Ministry of Agriculture (MOA), Govt. of India, has taken up during the 10th Five Year Plan, a programme on Strengthening of Database and Information Networking for Indian Fisheries Sector in which Marine Fisheries Census is a major component. Recognising the expertise and experience of CMFRI in conducting such massive census surveys, the DAHD&F, MOA has entrusted the task of conducting the All India Marine Fisheries Census in the mainland to CMFRI.

Frame of the survey, namely, the marine fishing villages available with CMFRI was validated and updated with the latest information obtained from the respective maritime states. After identification of census parameters such as the population size, education, religion, occupation, number of crafts and number of gears etc., the necessary schedules were designed to collect information and these were approved by the Technical Monitoring Committee set up by DAHD&F, MOA.

The census was conducted in two phases with the first phase covering all the maritime states and Union Territories except Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry which

were covered during second phase. The first phase was conducted during April-June, 2005 and the second during November-December, 2005. Over 300 CMFRI staff (Scientific and Technical) supervised the field level and zonal level census operations ensuring proper collection of relevant data. A total of 1,492 field enumerators mostly drawn from the fishing communities/fishing villages covered 3,202 marine fishing villages. After completion of the census in both the phases, the data were sent to headquarters for processing and preparation of reports. The software required for data entry, data validation and processing was developed by the scientists of Fishery Resources Assessment Division, CMFRI.

The final report (containing two parts) on the marine fisheries census on an All India basis with respective state summaries including the scope, census parameters, their definitions, the types of schedules and instructions for collection of data was released by Shri.P.M.A. Hakeem, I.A.S., Secretary, DAHD&F, Ministry of Agriculture, Govt of India on 25 July 2006 at Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi.

The rapid census exercises and the information supplied by the state department resulted in the finalization of 39 marine fishing villages spread over two districts in Goa. Conscious efforts were made to avoid villages that were estuarial and other inland fishery regions. Further in the villages only those households were selected where at least one member of the family was involved in marine fishing or allied activities. This publication (Part III of the Census report) summarises the districtwise census data of Goa covering a range of information right from the population bifurcation among Goa fisherfolk to the ownership pattern of different craft, either full or partial. For a better understanding of the craft and gear ownership vis-à-vis occupational fishing, specially assorted information on number of households, which thrives by fishing without any wherewithal, has also been presented. Such incisive processing will be of much use to the planners and state authorities, whose primary objective is targeted towards the 'have-nots' of fishery. This report contains an exhaustive list of fishing villages of Goa along with their socio-occupational profile including the craft and gear infrastructure segregated sector-wise.

I take this opportunity to thank the DAHD&F and the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) for entrusting CMFRI with this onerous responsibility, which has been completed within a reasonable time span. Special mention is required to laud the role played by CMFRI personnel especially, Dr. V.S. Kakati, SIC, Karwar Research Centre of CMFRI and the associated scientific and technical staff who made this venture a success with their dedicated and tireless efforts. I hope this report in this current shape and form will be of immense utility to the quintessential observer of Indian Marine Fishery.

SUMMARY

Marine Fisheries Census 2005 was carried out in two districts of the State of Goa. The scope, time frame, the parameters, their definitions and types of schedules used are described in Part I and Part II of the Marine Fisheries Census Report. The salient features are summarised below:-

- There are in all 34 landing centres in Goa. Number of landing centers in South Goa district is 21 and North Goa district has 13 landing centres.
- There are 39 marine fishing villages in Goa. South Goa district has 26 fishing villages and North Goa district has 13 fishing villages.
- Goa has 1,963 fishermen families. South Goa district has the maximum number (71%). North Goa has 29%.
- The total marine fisherfolk population in the state is 10,668 out of which adult male constitute 38%, adult female 35% and children 27%.
- Districtwise analysis of the fisherfolk population shows that the maximum number is in South Goa district (69%) and remaining 31% belong to North Goa.
- Average fishermen population per village is about 274 and family size is 5.4
- 16% of the fishermen population in the State of Goa acquired primary education,
 43% secondary, 10% above secondary and 31% have no formal education.
- The number of fisherfolk engaged in actual fishing is 2,515 forming 24% of the total fishermen population.
- Out of 2,515 fisherfolk engaged in actual fishing, 60% engaged in fulltime fishing, 32% part-time and 8% occasional.
- Out of 6,399 fisherfolk occupied in the fishery activities 39% are active fishermen and 53% are engaged in other activities such as marketing, repairing/making nets, curing, processing, peeling, labourer and other allied activities. The remaining 8% are engaged in other activities not related to fishery.

- Out of 1,963 fishermen families in the State of Goa, majority of the families are Hindus (62%), followed by Christians (37%) and Muslims constitute the rest (1%). There is no fishermen families belong to SC/ST category.
- About 3% fisherfolk have membership in Fisheries and other Co-operative Societies.
- In Goa, 2,551 fishing crafts are in the fishery out of which 43% are mechanized, 36% motorized and the remaining 21% are non-mechanized crafts. In the mechanized crafts 76% are trawlers, 18% are purse-seiners, 5% are gillnetters and the remaining 1% form others.
- Out of 1,831 fishing crafts are owned by the fishermen of Goa. 21% are mechanized,
 51% are motorized and the remaining 28% are non-motorized.
- Among the mechanized, 65% are trawlers, 22% are purse-seiners, 12% are gillnetters. The remaining 1% comprise others.
- Among the motorized sector, fibre glass boat forms 7%, ring seiner 23%, and plank-built boat 68%. The remaining 2% comprise others.
- In non-motorized sector, 64% are plank-built boats and 36% are dugout.
- Important gears of Goa are gillnets, trawl nets and drift nets. Sharing pattern of gears was more visible in shore seines. Number of gillnets in Goa is given as number of pieces. About 26,348 pieces of gillnet are owned by the fishermen.
- About 181 fishermen families possess electronic gadgets and 43 families possess life saving equipment.
- Nearly 21% of the fisherfolk possess neither craft nor gear.
- In Goa 28% of the fishermen houses are kutcha houses and 72% are pucca houses.
- There about 146 Primary schools, 87 Secondary schools, 20 Colleges and 12 Technical Institutions in the fishing villages.
- 30 fishing villages in the State are electrified and connected by road, 29 villages have bus stop/stand.






