Brief report on recently inaugurated Ganguli 'Mini Fisheries Harbour'

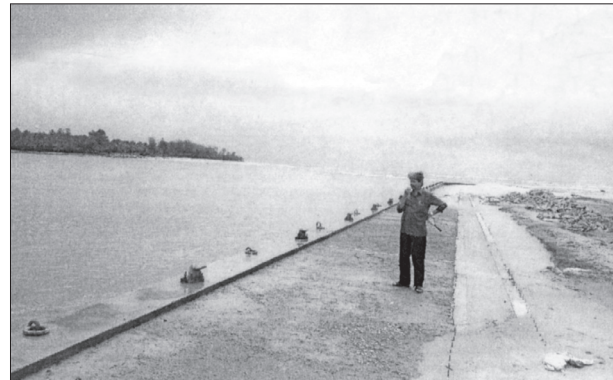

Ganguli is one of the major mechanized fish landing centres of North Kanara Coast. For enhancing harbour facility and fish production from North Kanara District, a 'Mini Fisheries Harbour' was constructed recently. The Mini Fisheries Harbour, which was under construction for the last five years was inaugurated and opened to the public by honourable Fisheries Minister of Karnataka state on 24-08-2007.
