



CMFRI clears 300kg waste off Puthuvype shore

IN a beach clean-up drive as part of World Ocean Day, the ICAR-Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) removed around 300 kg of litter from Puthuvype beach on Tuesday.

The clean-up was carried out by staff and research scholars of CMFRI's Marine Biodiversity, Environment and Management Division at Puthuvype, which attracts large numbers of tourists.

Participants segregated waste, which included plastic bottles, food packaging, fishing debris, and other non-biodegradable litter that had accumulated along the shoreline.
