The Interactive E-Learning Module on Protected Elasmobranchs of India is a comprehensive digital learning platform developed by ICAR-Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute to enhance awareness and understanding of legally protected sharks and rays in India. The module provides an engaging, self-paced learning experience through interactive multiple-choice assessments based on the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (as amended in 2022), CITES provisions, species identification, conservation status, and sustainable fisheries management. Designed as both a web-based and mobile-compatible application, it serves as an effective educational resource for capacity building among diverse stakeholders.

Purpose of the Module

- Enhance knowledge of protected sharks and rays occurring in Indian waters.
- Improve understanding of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and CITES provisions relevant to elasmobranch conservation.
- Strengthen the capacity of stakeholders involved in fisheries, conservation, research, and enforcement.
- Promote informed decision-making for the conservation and sustainable management of protected elasmobranchs.

Key Features

The module offers a structured and interactive learning experience through multiple-choice questions covering species identification, legal protection, conservation, fisheries, and trade regulations. It includes real-time scoring, countdown timer, question navigation, performance summary, and result export, enabling users to evaluate their understanding and monitor learning progress. The platform is accessible through both web and mobile devices, providing a convenient and user-friendly interface for self-learning and assessment.
